 - Vote on it soon

 - We don't have a lot of money, but Connie said undergrads put in 4% of the student union
 - They don't really even have a budget, so it's hard to say what they wanted to do, but it actually was 4%
 - \$100 is 4%

 - Latrice was doing this, but Jane Lawrence should know for sure
 - Plans for external donors as well need to be considered
