 - iii) List of recommendations developed by the Title IX Board should be published as soon as the Office of the President approves it

c) What is needed from the GSA?

i) Noting right now but when UCOP publishes the recommendations it would be great if the GSA provides a letter of support

Question: How many cases are backed up?

- About 100 just at UC Merced
- # Way higher at other institutions
- d) Alex will check with the Union to see what grad students are mandated reporters & who aren't
- e) With a lot of the Appendix E changes, a lot is being pushed into student affairs

Question: Are there changes for Ombuds that may be coming into effect with the Title IX changes?

- The GSA may need to ask Dean Zatz
- f) How to insure that the GSA keeps grad students informed?
