Department Updates

- Management of Complex Systems
 - o Had funding application for research equipment, software
 - o Trying to update website with student profiles & other info.
- Cognitive & Information Sciences
 - o Also has similar funding opportunity, funds previously allocated for inviting speakers, now offered to graduate students
 - Recommended other departments investigate similar avenues for potential funds
- Political Science
 - o The department is thinking through and contending with issues with visa and location during the pandemic/distance learning
 - Potential solutions: different working titles
 - Interested in any other solutions other departments are pursuing
- Quantitative and Systems Biology
 - o Working through how to handle SWAG (shirts, stickers, mugs, merchandise)
- Public Health
 - o Planning end-of-semester social (Jackbox party games)
- Materials & Biomaterials Science and Engineering

- o A student in the department suggested doing a diversity showcase for graduate students
 - Will connect with Benny, IVP, because the IVP is currently trying to build relationships w/ GSOs who may be an asset in such an event
 - Office of EDI was also suggested as a resource
- Jay Colond
 - o Katie Butterfield wants to offer resources for teaching/support a worker coop in response to the privatization of the ECEC. Email her for more info.
 - The GSA is currently working graduate students on this issue; more information will be sent by Benny.

GSO and Sponsored Events Funding

- Call for applications not yet happened, but will occur soon; Adam will contact Quy, GSA Treasurer
- The DA will be involved with reviewing and scoring funding applications from GSOs
- The process: Call for applications made by GSA Treasurer → DA reviews those applications → GSA Treasurer (and potentially IVP) will interpret those scores to allocate funds

Survey Progress & Process for Approval

- Adam looked into the survey distribution process; will send out that email chain o There is concern with over-surveying
 - o There is a one-month long approval process
- The survey is tentatively cancelled, instead the following actions will be pursued:
 - Looking at past & existing surveys, see what is already being done.
 - Specifically, look for data from the survey conducted in the summer
 - Thinking about actionable things delegates can do to support their students.
 - We are all very aware of issues graduate students face, however, whether that issue is within the scope of the delegate to change or advocate for is another dimension.

Fellowship

- A student's issue w/ the disbursement of fellowship funds and not knowing who to contact/bogged by the chain of command
- Delegates will research and collaborate on specifying and making aware the chain of command for disbursement of these fellowship funds

o This case is good example of actionable items delegates can undertake

Mental Health Resources

- Would like to involve a CAPS in a meeting (potentially next month's meeting) to discuss mental health resources, especially during the pandemic.
 - o Want to leverage the position of the DA to push these conversations into actual change
